In 2000 he began working with the homeless and addicted as a case manager and Genesis counselor at the Portland Rescue Mission, in Portland, Oregon. In 2006 Dean moved to Devon, UK where he created a full program based on Genesis, while serving as Program Manager for Gilead Foundations' men and women's residential recovery program. In 2008 Michael Dye, author of the Genesis Process, invited Dean to join him as a Genesis trainer and program consultant, specializing in residential program development. Besides working with Mike, he has directed programs at missions in Everett, WA and Las Vegas, NV. He is the author of the Genesis Residential Program Manual, the Mystery of Addiction recovery class, and currently works as a full time consultant advising the leadership of new and existing programs. He continues to travel and train counselors and programs in the Genesis process throughout the USA and overseas.
